overnor Umo Eno, on Thursday, November 6, performed the groundbreaking ceremony of the Federal Housing Authority (FHA) Renewed Hope Estate at Ekpene Ukim in Uruan Local Government Area, marking the official commencement of President Bola Tinubu's Housing Project in the State.

Governor Eno described the initiative as a clear demonstration of productive collaboration between the State and Federal governments, expressing

### Gov Eno Fulfils Promise on AKBC Upgrade, Signs Pact for Integrated Broadcasting Project

n a major step towards overhauling the State's information and communication infrastructure, Governor Umo Eno, on Wednesday, November 5, entered into a partnership with MediaGuru Consultant, LLC, Dubai, for the transformation of the Akwa Ibom Broadcasting Corporation (AKBC), into a world-class integrated broadcast station.

The agreement, signed at Government House, Uyo, underscores the administration's commitment to modernising the State-owned media outfit and enhancing its capacity to deliver high-quality broadcasting services comparable to international standards.

Governor Eno, who was represented by the Secretary to the State Government, Prince Enobong Uwah, explained that the contract covers consultancy, design, procurement, and installation of cutting-edge broadcast equipment. He emphasised that the initiative aligns with his campaign pledge to reposition AKBC as a major communication hub in Nigeria.





"I want to welcome everyone to the signing ceremony of this agreement between the Akwa Ibom State Government and MediaGuru Consultant, LLC, for the provision of consultancy, design, procurement, and installation of broadcast equipment for AKBC," the Governor stated.

#### **AKSG Approves N1.39 Trillion Budget for 2026 Fiscal Year**

he Akwa Ibom State Government, has approved a total budget size of ₩1.390 trillion for the 2026 fiscal year.

The budget proposal, was approved for onward transmission to the Akwa Ibom State House of Assembly, on Wednesday, November 5, during an enlarged State Exco meeting presided over by Governor Umo Eno at Government House, Uyo.

Welcoming members and other attendees, including Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Extra-Ministerial Departments, Governor Eno, noted that the budget, anchored on deepening the dividends of the ARISE Agenda, prioritises agricultural development, rural transformation, infrastructure expansion, education, tourism growth, healthcare advancement, economic diversification, and environmental sustainability.

The approved 2026 fiscal plan, emphasises the completion of ongoing flagship projects, job creation through Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) support and tourism promotion, improvement in transportation through the deployment of CNG buses and ferries, as well as the promotion of transparency, fiscal discipline, and human capital development, particularly for women, youths, and vulnerable groups.

Urging continued dedication and commitment to the effective implementation of the ARISE Agenda for sustainable growth and inclusive development across the State, the government also ratified the approval of the Finance and General Purpose Committee (FGPC) on various projects, including the upward review of the total project cost for the Aviation Village at the Victor Attah International Airport.

In another major decision, Council endorsed the FGPC's approval for the consultancy, design, procurement, and installation of broadcast equipment and system integration for AKBC Television and Radio, awarded to a MediaGuru LLC, Dubai. The move aims at enhancing broadcast quality and strengthening the corporation's

technical capacity.

Following a presentation by the Commissioner for Health, Dr. Ekem John on the ongoing State of Emergency in the Health Sector, the State government approved the immediate deployment of re-engaged retired health workers on contract to health facilities across the State. The Ministry of Health was also directed to commence work on eight General Hospitals, 29 Primary Healthcare Centres, and the Molecular Diagnostics/State Public Health Laboratory and Isolation Centre, while Tuesday, November 18, was approved as new date for the commissioning of the General Hospital, Ukanafun.

In a significant step to reclaim valuable State assets, approval was given for the release of N4.15 billion to Anchor Insurance Limited to recover prime properties earlier exchanged during the company's recapitalisation process. The Governor further directed the appointment of a reputable estate valuer to assess the Lagos-based properties and mandated APICO and AKICORP to work collaboratively in converting such assets into wealthgenerating ventures for the State.

Additionally, reports were received from AKICORP on the financial health of State-owned financial institutions with directive that the management of each institution should appear before the Executive Council in subsequent meetings for detailed presentations.

The Attorney-General and Commissioner for Justice, Uko Udom, SAN, also presented proposed Executive Bills, including the Domestication and Harmonization of Taxes and Levies Bill and the Akwa Ibom State Property Tax Law, in line with the newly enacted National Tax Act. Also approved, was the transmission of the bills to the State House of Assembly for legislative consideration and passage. A related briefing from AKIRS outlined the implications of the new tax regime for the State's fiscal framework.

Commending the outgoing Head of Civil Service, Elder Effiong Essien for his meritorious service to the State, Governor Eno and Council members wished him continued success in his future endeavours. The news of the demise of a respected senior cleric in the State, Rev. Emmanuel Ossom was received, and members directed to pay a condolence visit to the bereaved family while praying for the peaceful repose of his soul.





## First Lady's Office Unveils Major Tech Training Drive for A'lbom Women

he Coordinator, Office of the First Lady, and Chairman, Board of Trustees of the Golden Initiative for All (GIFA), Lady Helen Obareki, has reiterated her dedication to advancing women's leadership in technology.

Lady Obareki made this known while announcing a major partnership, aimed at training 500 women in Akwa Ibom annually in essential digital and innovation skills.

Making the announcement during the GIFA Women in Tech Breakfast Roundtable with the theme, "Empowering Women in Tech: From Aspiring to Leadership," held on Wednesday, November 5, at Breakforth Hotel, Uyo, the Coordinator noted that the initiative serves as a strategic platform for female tech professionals, entrepreneurs, and innovators to engage on pathways to enhance women's participation in the technology ecosystem.

She disclosed that the collaboration between GIFA, Mosaic, and Afrilabs, the largest pan-African network of technology hubs and innovation centres, will provide training opportunities in critical areas such as software development, data analysis, and innovation management. According to her, the programme is designed to equip participants with market-relevant digital skills that will empower them to actively drive the State's digital economy.

"We are launching an intensive, year-round programme to train 500 Akwa Ibom women in technology-driven fields. Our vision is to create a pipeline of female developers, data analysts, and innovators who will not just participate in, but lead, the digital transformation of our State," Lady Obareki stated.

Emphasising the importance of women occupying leadership positions in technology, Lady Obareki noted that greater female representation in boardrooms and policymaking spaces enhances innovation outcomes. She further reaffirmed GIFA's resolve to break barriers limiting





women's participation in science and technology through mentorship, early access to resources, and structured skills development programmes.

Lady Obareki further described the roundtable as a significant contribution to Akwa Ibom's innovation and digital transformation agenda, commending the impressive turnout of female professionals. Their participation, according to her, was a demonstration of growing confidence in women's capacity to lead in the digital future of Akwa Ibom and Nigeria at large.

She called on women already excelling in technology to extend mentorship and create pathways for younger women, championing parity and advocacy for female

advancement in the sector. Lady Obareki also reaffirmed her office's readiness to collaborate with local and international organisations to expand GIFA's literacy, learning, and empowerment initiatives across all Local Government Areas.

## HoS Monitors Ongoing CBT Exam, Affirms Transparent Recruitment Process

he Head of Civil Service, Elder Effiong Essien, has assured candidates participating in the ongoing Akwa Ibom State Civil Service Recruitment Computer-Based Test (CBT), of a credible, foolproof, and merit-driven selection process.

Elder Essien gave the assurance on Tuesday, November 4, during a visit to the examination centre at the Civil Service Auditorium, Idongesit Nkanga Secretariat, Uyo.

Explaining that the CBT marks the beginning of the recruitment test for candidates in the teaching, mainstream, and health service cadres, the HoS emphasised that the computer-based method has enhanced orderliness, transparency, and fairness in the recruitment process.

He commended Governor Umo Eno for introducing innovative measures that have redefined recruitment process, noting that the inclusion of a Mock Test prior to the ARISE CBT Main Examination, allowed candidates to familiarise themselves with the process.

Elder Essien further disclosed that the examination is structured in daily batches to ensure smooth coordination and effective supervision. He expressed satisfaction with the conduct of the exercise and



lauded the cooperation of the candidates.

Also speaking, the Commissioner for Science and Digital Economy, Dr. Frank Ekpenyong, expressed delight over the orderly conduct of candidates and the smooth operation of the CBT process. He explained that each candidate undergoes verification before being admitted into the examination hall, and upon completion, receives their test scores instantly, both on screen and via email.


Dr. Ekpenyong clarified that the recruitment exercise extends beyond the CBT, as data generated from the test will be forwarded to the Civil Service Commission to determine qualified applicants for subsequent interview stages. He assured all applicants that those who applied for the recruitment will be scheduled to take part in the CBT.



Some candidates who spoke to newsmen applauded the transparent and well-organised process. They lauded the State government for providing a conducive environment that guarantees equal opportunity for all applicants. The CBT, they noted, reflects the government's commitment to reforming the civil service recruitment process and ensuring a fair, technology-driven system.


