



Gov Eno Calls For Responsible Speech, Respect For Leaders' Families

· Announces Unity Concert and Christmas Carol for December



kwa Ibom State Governor, Pastor Umo Eno, has reiterated his call for restraint in public utterances and responsible use of social media to preserve the peace and unity of the State and families.

The Governor who Spoke at the November edition of the Government House Covenant Service, held at the Banquet Hall, Government House, Uyo, the Governor cautioned against divisive comments and online behaviour capable of undermining social harmony.

Pastor Eno particularly urged citizens to show greater decorum and respect for families, especially those whom God has placed in positions of leadership, noting that words have the power to build or destroy.

"Try to stay away from unguarded utterances that are capable of causing dischord. The comments you make, whether in public or private, should uplift others. The person you destroy today may be the one you'll need tomorrow. Let's project our leaders and stand by them," the Governor said.

Governor Eno also announced two major events scheduled for December, the Unity Concert on December 6 and the Akwa Ibom Christmas Carol on December 19 — both aimed at fostering unity and thanksgiving among citizens.

He explained that this year's Christmas Carol will maintain a purely spiritual focus, featuring only traditional carols in celebration of the birth of Christ.

"Don't come and sing anything that's not a carol on the 19th," he emphasized. "You can act it, dramatize it, or interpret it creatively, but let it remain a carol."

The Governor thanked Akwa Ibom people for their consistent participation in the monthly Covenant Service and prayed that the new month would bring peace, progress, and divine comfort to all.



ARISE Project Tracking Series Commences in Abak, Etim Ekpo

• As govt reaffirms commitment to transparency, development

he Akwa Ibom State Government, has commenced the ARISE Project Tracking Series in Abak and Etim Ekpo Local Government Areas, marking the start of a statewide exercise to assess and publicise projects executed under Governor Umo Eno's administration.

Led by the Ministry of Information, the initiative aims to promote transparency, accountability, and effective documentation of the administration's development strides. The Commissioner for Information, Rt. Hon. Aniekan Umanah, who led the delegation, said the exercise reflects the Governor's commitment to open governance and measurable impact. He was accompanied by the Permanent Secretary, Akparawa James Edet; Mrs. Margaret Edem, Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Women Affairs; Dr. Eunice Egharevba, Director of Documentation and Archives; and engineers from the



Ministry of Works.

At Abak, the team was received by the Council Chairman, Hon. Ime Charles, who commended the initiative as a bold step that reinforces public confidence in the government. She praised Governor Eno's inclusive leadership and the ARISE Agenda, which, she noted, has inspired grassroots-driven projects.

The inspection covered key projects, including the Mega Oil Palm Processing Plant and Storage House at Ikot Akwa Ebom, a World Bank-assisted Nigeria for Women Project, managed by women cooperatives. Beneficiaries such as





Mrs. Enobong Bassey and Mrs. Emem Jimmy testified that the initiative has improved their livelihoods. The team also inspected major roads, including the 8.6km Ediene A b a k – I k o t E k a n R o a d , 10.4km Pepsi Junction—Ukpom—Abak Road, and the 18.9km Ibiakpan—Abiakpo Otoro—Abak Manta Road, among others.

In addition, six ARISE Compassionate Homes were visited, including one belonging to Mr. Sylvester Michael, a physically challenged beneficiary. The team also toured the Holy Child Convent Model Primary School, the Legislative Chambers Complex, and the Maternity and Child Health Clinic, all executed by the Abak Council.

In Etim Ekpo, the team was received by the Council Chairman, Hon. Gideon Uwa, who described Governor Eno's impact as unprecedented. He highlighted projects such as the 16km Etim Ekpo—Essien Udim Road, the Model Health Centre at Utu Ikot Nkor, and several internal roads that have turned the area into a construction hub.

Other projects inspected included, the 16km Midim Atan Ikot Inyang—Ikot Akpan Ekpenyong—Etok Uruk Eshiet—Ikot Imonte Road with a 30-metre bridge, the 11.6km Internal Roads Phase 1, and the 2.1km Obong University Access Road. The Project Manager, Engr. Johnny Ime of Nsik Engineering, reported steady progress, confirming that the Governor had released funds to sustain work despite weather-related delays.

Concluding the first phase, the Commissioner said the ARISE Project Tracking Series underscores Governor Eno's dedication to transparency, accountability, and peoplecentered governance. He assured that the exercise would continue across all the 31 local government areas to ensure that every government investment under the ARISE Agenda remains verifiable, and impactful.

AKSG Presents 2025 Q3 Budget Implementation Report

·Records 86.9% budget performance, reaffirms transparency, accountability

n line with its commitment to transparency, accountability, and open governance, the Akwa Ibom State Government, has presented the 2025 Third Quarter (Q3) Budget Implementation Report, reflecting an impressive 86.9 percent performance rate.

The report was presented on Wednesday, October 29, by the Commissioner for Budget and Economic Planning, Dr. Nsikan Nkan, during a media briefing, held at the ministry's conference room, Uyo.

Dr. Nkan described the exercise as a fulfillment of the administration's

promise to keep citizens informed about the State's financial performance, consistent with Governor Umo Eno's leadership style anchored on openness, sincerity, and accountability.

He noted that the quarterly briefing serves to dispel misinformation about the State's finances and reinforces the government's commitment to transparency and good governance.

Providing a detailed breakdown, the Commissioner explained that the 2025 Budget of Consolidation and Expansion, valued at ₦955 billion, recorded the following Q3 results as at September 30, Recurrent Revenue of ₦318,098,985,597.70, representing 108.1% performance. Recurrent Expenditure of ₦117,787,671,752.45, representing 77.1% performance and the Capital Expenditure of ₦419,270,014,524.20, representing 91.4% performance.

This brought the cumulative budget performance for Q1–Q3 to \$830,210,013,299.42, equivalent to 86.9% of the approved annual estimate.





Dr. Nkan further disclosed that the State had generated revenue beyond the initial budget projections, which necessitated the passage of a Supplementary Budget by the Akwa Ibom State House of Assembly. The Budget helmsman expressed appreciation to the State Information machinery for effectively promoting the ARISE Agenda and ensuring accurate information dissemination, as well as to the media community, particularly members of the Nigeria Union of Journalists (NUJ), for their balanced reportage.

The Commissioner for Information, Rt. Hon. Aniekan Umanah, represented by the Permanent Secretary, Akparawa James Edet, lauded the Governor Eno's openness and inclusive governance approach, describing the quarterly presentation as a hallmark of true democracy. He urged journalists to continue supporting the government's developmental strides while ensuring that their "breaking news does not break the society."

Also speaking, the State NUJ Chairman, Comrade Nsibiet John, applauded Dr. Nkan for sustaining the quarterly budget briefings, which he said have strengthened trust and eliminated public suspicion. He reaffirmed the media's commitment to objective reporting of government activities.

The presentation, according to observers, further underscores the Umo Eno administration's unwavering resolve to institutionalise transparency, accountability, and citizen engagement in governance.

Encouraged by Pastor Edet, Master Confidence applied to the school and personally met with the Commandant, sat for the entrance examination, and successfully passed. His admission into JSS 3 was subsequently approved, with all fees fully paid by Governor Eno.

He further revealed that representatives from the Support Groups Directorate will visit Confidence during the school's visiting day on November 1.

AKHA Seeks Establishment of Central Revenue Account for A'lbom Govt



he Akwa Ibom State House of Assembly, has called on the State government to establish and operationalise a State Central Revenue Account (SCRA) by the beginning of the 2026 fiscal year, to serve as a centralised treasury for all revenues generated across the State.

The House also urged the government to design and deploy a centralised multi-channel digital payment platform, to be named before the end of this year, that will integrate all Ministries, Departments, Agencies (MDAs) and local government areas (LGAs). The proposed platform, according to the lawmakers, should ensure that all government payments are made electronically and automatically remitted into the SCRA.

The resolution followed a motion sponsored by the House Leader and Member, representing Nsit Ubium State Constituency, Rt. Hon. Otobong Bob, and seconded by Hon. Udobia Udo, during Tuesday, October 28, plenary.

In his motion, Rt. Hon. Bob urged the Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of Science and Digital Economy, working jointly with the Accountant General's Office and the State Internal Revenue Service (AKIRS), to ensure that all MDAs and LGAs are boarded onto the platform within three months of its development. He explained that the system would facilitate the issuance of invoices, receipts, and permits, thereby reducing informal or manual cash handling in government transactions.

The House Leader, recalled that the Federal Government introduced the Treasury Single Account (TSA) policy in 2012 under the administration of President Goodluck Jonathan, which was later fully implemented by President Muhammadu Buhari's administration to consolidate all government revenues into a single account at the Central Bank of Nigeria (CBN).

Rt. Hon. Bob noted that several States, including Kano, Kaduna, Niger, Lagos, and Oyo, have already domesticated and adopted digital payment platforms that enable MDAs to collect and process payments through a centralised system. He explained that such systems allow citizens and residents to make payments for government services, levies, taxes, and remittances through various channels, including mobile apps, USSD codes, and online platforms, ensuring seamless and cashless revenue collection.

He also highlighted that countries such as India, Sri Lanka, Ghana, and even Nigeria (through REMITA), have successfully implemented integrated digital payment systems that make government remittances and services more efficient. According to him, the International Monetary Fund (IMF) recognises the Treasury Single Account as a key public finance management tool that consolidates cash resources, reduces borrowing costs, enhances fiscal transparency, and improves cash management.

Expressing concern, the House Leader warned that without the immediate establishment and full implementation of the SCRA, the State government may continue to suffer revenue leakages, mismanagement of funds, and inefficiencies in financial tracking and control.

The motion received broad support from other lawmakers, including, Rt. Hon. KufreAbasi Edidem, Rt. Hon. Effiong Johnson, Hon. Lawrence Udoide, and Hon. Itorobong Etim, who described the initiative as vital for promoting transparency, accountability, and fiscal discipline in public finance management.

In his ruling, the Speaker, Rt. Hon. Udeme Otong, directed the Clerk of the Assembly, Mrs. NsikakAbasi Orok, to convey the House's resolution to Governor Umo Eno for prompt implementation.


