Gov Eno Approves Maintenance of 83 Roads at On-going Ministerial Briefings

• Okays health counterpart funds, education support, food distribution



Following reports at the ongoing ministerial briefings, Governor Umo Eno, has approved the maintenance of 83 roads within the Uyo metropolis and the full rehabilitation of Aka Itiam Road.

The Governor disclosed this after receiving an update from the Ministry of Works and Fire Service, directing that all failed portions of roads be fixed with immediate effect. He confirmed that Amitec Construction and Development Limited has been mobilised and mandated to complete the repairs before the end of the dry season.

Roads listed for maintenance include, sections of Oron Road, Udo Umana, Udo Eduok, Okon Essien, Plaza Bypass, Ikot Ekpene Road, Abak Road, Clement Isong Street, parts of Nsikak Eduok Avenue, and Port Harcourt Street.

Other affected locations are the Itam Junction Roundabout, parts of Obio Imo Street, D'Angelo Hotel and EFCC Roads in Ewet Housing Estate, Johnson Street off Aka Road, Ekpenyong Street, among others within the State capital.

Governor Eno also received briefings from the Ministries of Humanitarian Affairs, Education,



and Health. He approved the first-quarter distribution of food items to vulnerable citizens by the Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs, scheduled to take place during the forthcoming Easter period.

For the Education sector, the Governor approved the payment of first and second term subventions for public primary, secondary, and technical colleges, as well as payment of WASSCE, NABTEB, and science practical fees for students of Akwa Ibom State origin in public schools. He also approved the



procurement of uniforms, bags, and shoes for pupils in model primary schools.

In the Health sector, Governor Eno approved all 2025 health-related counterpart funding, including health insurance, primary healthcare, immunisation, family planning, and nutrition programmes. He further authorised the release of the 2024 Medical Residency Training Fund, revitalisation of the State Central Medical Stores, and issuance of appointment letters to newly engaged contract staff, commending the ministry's reforms and urging sustained performance in 2026.

Gov Eno Begins Two-Weeks Ministerial Briefing, Demands Accountability



Governor Umo Enoka, has declared open a two-week ministerial briefing at the State Executive Council Chambers, Government House, Uyo, to front load the State's priorities and reinforce effective service delivery in line with the ARISE Agenda.

Governor Enoka stated this on Monday, January 12, stressing that governance under his leadership will remain focused, disciplined, and people-centred.

The Governor explained that the briefing became necessary as 2026 will combine governance with political activities, making it imperative for government officials to remain focused, strategic, and efficient in programme execution.

According to him, the daily briefings, scheduled from January 12 - 21, will feature detailed presentations from members of the Executive Council as well as Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs). He added that each Commissioner is required to attend alongside their Permanent Secretary, Delivery Advisers, and other relevant officers.

The Governor urged Council members to use the platform to give a clear account of their stewardship, including achievements recorded in 2025 and projections for 2026, emphasising that all

plans and activities must strictly align with the ARISE Agenda.

He disclosed that the State currently has over sixty priority projects outside road construction, noting that no new projects will be approved unless they directly impact the people, align with the ARISE Agenda, and fall within available budgetary provisions.

Looking ahead to the general election, Governor Enoka charged Commissioners to be ready to present the administration's report cards to the public. He announced that from February, Commissioners will engage in compulsory monthly press briefings and weekly radio programmes such as Matters Arising, reaffirming his commitment to transparency, accountability, and result-driven governance across the State.



Reclaimed Uyo Village Dumpsite to Host GRA, Creative Hub, Housing - Gov Eno



Governor Umo Eno, has announced plans to transform the reclaimed Uyo Village dumpsite into a modern Government Residential Area (GRA), incorporating a creative village and a housing estate aimed at reducing housing deficit.

The Governor disclosed this on Tuesday, January 6, while responding to questions from Government House correspondents after inspecting the reclaimed site, which spans over 100 hectares. The inspection also covered a ravine-prone landscape that has been sand-filled in preparation for future development.

Governor Eno described the project as a demonstration of vision and foresight, noting that the land, once a major dumpsite, has been fully reclaimed and designated for structured development, including housing, agriculture, and other uses. He added that proper mapping and water channels have been put in place to support sustainable development.

According to him, the ravine area will be transformed to accommodate the Uyo GRA, with plans for about 150 middle-income housing units, alongside a

creative village connected by a spur road. The initiative, he said, will open up previously unusable land, address erosion challenges, and create new development corridors close to the Uyo city centre.

The Governor explained that his visit was necessitated by the need to personally assess the road design and gain a comprehensive understanding of the scope of work being executed by contractors, beyond earlier technical briefings received in his office. He expressed satisfaction with the level of progress recorded so far on the site.

Reaffirming the administration's commitment to quality and timely delivery, Governor Eno urged contractors handling government projects to adhere strictly to standards. He averred that the Uyo Village road and housing project would play a key role in addressing housing needs through middle-income and other strategic residential developments.

Governor Eno further stated that ongoing infrastructure projects across the State are creating significant employment opportunities for youths and local workers. He encouraged young people to embrace these opportunities and uphold a strong work ethic, noting that the 2026 budget of N1.584 trillion reflects the scale of development planned to position Akwa Ibom on a path comparable with global cities.

Gov Eno Charges A'Ibom Youths on Self-Devt, Peace Building

Governor Umo Eno, has charged Akwa Ibom youths to prioritise self-development and avoid actions capable of disrupting the peace and unity currently enjoyed across the State.

The Governor gave the charge during a breakfast meeting with the leadership of the National Youth Council of Nigeria (NYCN), Akwa Ibom State chapter on Saturday, January 10.

Governor Eno explained that the creation of a separate Ministry of Youth Development was aimed at giving focused attention to youth-centred programmes and policies. He said his administration has been deliberate about youth empowerment through initiatives such as the Dakkada Skills Acquisition Centre (DASAC) and the Ibom Leadership and Entrepreneurial Development Centre (Ibom-LED).

He urged youths to take full advantage of the numerous opportunities available in the State for personal growth and collective advancement. On the 2027 elections, the Governor cautioned the youths against allowing themselves to be used to inflame the polity, stressing the need for peace to prevail at all times.

The Secretary to the State Government, Prince Enobong Uwah, advised the youths to see themselves as leaders, noting that the NYCN serves as a breeding ground for future leaders. He added that Governor Eno has shown strong commitment to youth inclusion through appointments and empowerment programmes, urging



them to remain law-abiding.

Also speaking, Hon. Martins Esin, Member representing Oron/Mbo/Okobo/Udung Uko/Urue Offong/Oruko Federal Constituency and Chairman, House Committee on Youth Development, commended the Governor's investments in youth training and empowerment. He highlighted the administration's plan to establish youth-friendly centres across the 31 local government areas and assured the Governor of youths' continued support beyond 2027.

Gov Eno Signs N1.584trn 2026 Budget, Inaugurates TSA, Airport Committees



Governor Umo Eno, has formally signed into law the 2026 N1.584 trillion People's Budget of Expansion and Growth, duly passed by the Akwa Ibom State House of Assembly.

Governor Eno signed the budget during the enlarged State Exco Meeting held on Monday, January 5, at Government House, Uyo, with the Deputy Governor, Senator Akon Eyakenyi; the Secretary to the State Government, Prince Enobong Uwah; the Head of Service, Mrs. Elsie Peters; Executive Assistant and Chief Delivery Advisor, Mr. Aniefiok Johnson; Commissioners, Special Advisers, Permanent Secretaries, and Chairmen of Boards and Commissions in attendance.

Welcoming members to the first meeting of the year, Governor Eno described 2026 as a year of expansion and consolidation, as well as the formal commencement of the political season. He commended the House of Assembly for the expeditious passage of the budget, lauding the prevailing cooperation between the Executive, Legislative, and Judiciary arms of government.

The Governor charged Council members, whom he referred to as the administration's "first eleven" and key executors of the ARISE Agenda, to recommit themselves to prompt and decisive actions in delivering the government's development blueprint.

He further reiterated the full implementation of the Treasury Single Account (TSA) with effect from January 1, 2026, stressing strict compliance by all Ministries, Departments,

and Agencies (MDAs). According to him, the TSA policy is aimed at strengthening accountability, boosting internally generated revenue (IGR), reducing dependence on federal allocations, and supporting economic diversification through strategic investments, particularly in tourism and other priority sectors.

The State Chief Executive further approved the inauguration of two strategic committees, Committee on the Implementation of the Treasury Single Account (TSA) and Internally Generated Revenue (IGR), and the Committee for the Actualization of the International Status of the Victor Attah International Airport, Uyo.

Committee on the Implementation of the Treasury Single Account (TSA) and Internally Generated Revenue (IGR), is chaired by Mr. Emem Bob, Commissioner for Finance, and has Dr. Frank Ekpenyong, Commissioner for Science and Digital Economy; Mr. Frank Archibong, Commissioner for Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs; Dr. Ubong Inyang, Commissioner for Lands and Town Planning and Dr. Linus Nkan, Commissioner for Budget and Economic Planning as members, while Mr. Okon Okon, Chairman, Akwa Ibom State Internal Revenue Service (AKIRS) will serve as Secretary.

The Committee for the Actualization of the International Status of Victor Attah International Airport, Uyo, is to be chaired by

Prince Enobong Uwah, Secretary to the State Government as Chairman, with Uko Udom, SAN, Attorney-General and Commissioner for Justice; Mr. Emem Bob, Commissioner for Finance and Special Duties; Mr. Uwem Ekanem, Managing Director, Airport Development Authority (Secretary); Mr. George Uriesi, Managing Director, Ibom Air; Engr. Ephraim Udosen, Permanent Secretary, Special Duties and Pastor Uwem Andrew Essien, Accountant-General as members.

Gov Eno Unveils Implementation Committee for APC Congress

Pastor Eno Commences 2026 With Thanksgiving, Urges Maturity, Respectful Politics

Pastor Umo Eno, has called on citizens and political actors to demonstrate maturity, peace and tolerance as preparations toward the 2027 general elections gradually begin, warning against actions capable of disrupting the prevailing unity and stability in the State.

The Governor gave the charge during a Special Inter-Denominational New Year Thanksgiving Service, held on Sunday, December 4, at the International Worship Centre, Uyo, where he commended political leaders across party lines for their maturity in handling sensitive issues, noting that such conduct has sustained peace and accelerated development in the State.

Governor Eno urged citizens to engage constructively in political discourse, stressing that while disagreement is a democratic right, it must be expressed respectfully. He emphasised that political differences should not degenerate into insults, hostility or violence, appealing to all to preserve the atmosphere of peace currently enjoyed across Akwa Ibom.

Speaking on governance reforms, the Governor announced the full introduction of the Treasury Single Account (TSA) system, explaining that the policy is designed to enhance revenue generation,



transparency and accountability. He directed all Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) to comply strictly, noting that no agency is permitted to generate and spend funds outside the TSA framework.

Governor Eno disclosed that the State has proposed a N1.5 trillion budget, stressing that effective revenue consolidation through the TSA is critical to funding development projects. He pledged his commitment to budget discipline and appealed for the cooperation of public officials and citizens to ensure successful implementation of the policy.

In his sermon, the guest preacher and Founder of Eternity Network International, Apostle Joshua Selmán, who ministered on the theme, “The God of All Flesh,” taken from Jeremiah 32:27, reminded Christians that their impact is tied to their knowledge of God. He urged believers to remain humble, trust God in challenging times and rely on Him as the God of all possibilities. The service also featured goodwill remarks from the CAN Chairman, Bishop Chris Nyong, who praised the Governor for sustaining peace, as well as praise, worship and Bible reading by the Coordinator, Office of the First Lady, Lady Helen Obareki.
